Podcast Transcript – Describe a Person

Anna: Hello... It's late.. the world is very quiet now. But I am glad you are here with us. Mike and I were just thinking about something.. Something simple, but also.. a bit complex. We were thinking about people.. and how we describe a person.. It's interesting, isn't it?

Mike: It is, Anna.. very interesting. Honestly.. it feels like the perfect time to talk about it. The night is gentle.. and we can just.. be here. Let's spend some time together. Why Describing People Is Hard

Mike: To be honest, Anna.. Sometimes I feel a bit lost when I need to describe a person in English. My vocabulary.. it feels too simple, you know? The other day.. I saw a man.. he was very short.. and he had these amazing.. bright blue eyes. He looked friendly.. very kind, I feel. But I didn't know the words to say all that. I just said.. 'He is a man.'

Anna: Honestly, Mike.. I understand. That happens to me too. The words.. they just escape sometimes. But simple is okay, I feel. Simple words are honest. When you think about someone.. maybe they are a smart person. Or maybe you want to focus on their character traits.. what makes them special inside. For me.. kind is a beautiful word. When someone is kind.. I feel.. safe. It's better than being tall.. I think.

Mike: I agree. Simple is good. Sometimes.. I imagine a person.. and I ask myself, 'what does he look like?' but then I remember.. the real person is inside. They might be friendly when you meet them.. they might be smart.. And those things are what you remember.. long after you forget if they were tall or short. It's about how they make you feel.

Anna: Yes.. Exactly. We should share more. We should use our words.. even simple ones.. to share these feelings. Because everyone is special.. right? Everyone has their own quiet story.

Friendly, Kind & Smart Explained

Anna: Mike.. we used some nice words. Like friendly. Friendly. It's a warm word, I feel. What does it mean to you.. really?

Mike: Friendly.. Hmm. Honestly.. Friendly to me is like.. when you are lost.. and someone smiles at you. It is a quiet help. A friendly smile doesn't cost anything.. but

it changes the day. It's a good word for when you want to describe a person who makes the world better. And kind.. that is similar. A kind person.. they do things for other people.. quietly. They don't want a medal. They are just.. kind.

Anna: That is beautiful. Friendly is the smile.. and kind is the action. Thank you, Mike. And what about smart? Smart. It feels important.. but sometimes it feels.. distant?

Mike: To be honest.. smart to me is not just about books. A smart person.. they understand things. They understand you. It's a quiet intelligence. They can be friendly and smart at the same time. I know one person like that. They have great character traits. It's a lovely mix, I feel.

Anna: I see. Yes.. it is about the gentle clear way they see the world. Not shouting their answers. Just.. quietly being smart. I like that very much. It makes me feel.. a little bit smarter too. Simple words.. but they mean so much.

Imagining People in a Quiet Cafe

Mike: Anna.. let's just.. imagine something for a moment. Imagine a very quiet morning. You are sitting in a small cafe.. the sun is just coming up. You see someone sitting across from you. Maybe they are tall.. sitting very straight.. or maybe they are a bit short.. hiding in a big sweater. It sounds nice, doesn't it? Just watching the world wake up.. and thinking about the people around us.

Anna: It sounds.. peaceful. In that moment.. I feel like I want to know their story. I look at them and I wonder.. 'what does he look like' when he is happy? Is he friendly? Does he have a kind heart? Sometimes.. I imagine that everyone in that cafe is smart in their own way.. with their own secret dreams. We all have these character traits that we carry around like hidden treasures.

Mike: Honestly.. I love that. In my dream.. the person across from me has bright blue eyes.. and when they look at the sunrise.. those eyes just.. sparkle. They look so kind.. so open. You don't even need to speak. You just know that they are a good person. It's a very quiet way to describe a person.. without using many words. Just feeling their presence in the room.

Anna: Yes.. exactly. It's about the feeling. Whether someone is tall or short.. it doesn't really change the peace of the morning. But knowing that people are friendly.. and smart.. and gentle.. that makes the coffee taste better, I think. It makes the world feel a little bit smaller.. and much more beautiful. Just for a moment.

Repeat After Us

Mike: I feel so calm now... I think it is time for us to just.. try some of these words together. No pressure. No tests. Just you and us.. in the quiet. I want you to try to say it with me.. very softly. Let's start with a beautiful one.. friendly.. One more time.. softly.. friendly.. It's a warm word, isn't it?

Anna: It really is. Now.. let's try to talk about the inside. The word is.. kind.. Just a whisper.. kind.. I feel like that word has a lot of heart. And another one.. for the people who understand the world.. smart.. Again.. smart.. You are doing so well. It's just a sound in the air.. but it means so much.

Mike: Honestly.. you sound very gentle. Let's try a physical one now. Think of someone you know with blue eyes. Let's say it together.. blue eyes.. And one more time.. blue eyes.. And when you want to know about someone.. you ask.. 'what does he look like?' Try it slowly.. 'what does he look like?' Perfect.

Anna: I feel like we are all connected through these sounds. One last word.. for the soul.. character traits.. It's a bit long.. but take your time.. character traits.. You are a natural. These words are yours now. You can use them to describe your friends.. your family.. or even the people in your dreams. Just keep them close to your heart.

Remember the Words We Learned

Mike: The air feels so still now.. But before we let the night go.. let's hold onto these words for just a moment longer. It is like keeping a small light burning. We talked about being tall and short.. and those beautiful blue eyes that see the world so clearly. It is funny.. how these small details stay with us.

Anna: They do... They stay in the heart. I feel like we found the real magic today in the words like friendly and kind. To describe a person is to really see them. Whether they are smart or just have wonderful character traits.. it all matters. It makes them who they are.

Mike: Honestly.. it does. We know now how to ask.. 'what does he look like?' and how to answer with a gentle soul. You have everything you need to share your thoughts about the people you love.. or the people you meet in the quiet of the night.

Goodnight and Keep Learning

Mike: Well.. the moon is high now.. and the world is dreaming. I think it is time for us to say goodbye for tonight. I hope you feel a little more peaceful.. a little more at home with these words. Thank you for spending this quiet time with Anna and me. It really was.. a gift.

Friendly /'frend.li/ — adjective → a person who is nice and easy to talk to.

Kind /kaɪnd/ — adjective → a person who cares about others and does nice things.

Smart /smɑ:rt/ — adjective → a person who understands things quickly and easily.

Gentle /'dʒen.təl/ — adjective → a person who is soft, calm, and not rough.

Tall /tɔ:l/ — adjective → a person who has a greater height than average.

Short /ʃɔ:rt/ — adjective → a person who has a smaller height than average.

Blue eyes /blu: aɪz/ — noun phrase → eyes that are blue in colour.

Character traits /'kær.ɪk.tər treɪts/ — noun phrase → the parts of a person's personality, like being kind or friendly.

Peaceful /'pi:s.fəl/ — adjective → calm and quiet, without any stress or noise.

Describe /dɪ'skraɪb/ — verb → to say what someone or something is like.

Useful English Phrases

What does he look like? → use this question to ask about someone's physical appearance.

She is really nice. → use this to say someone is friendly and kind.

He has blue eyes. → use this to describe someone's eye colour.

I think he is smart. → use this when you believe someone is intelligent.

She is a kind person. → use this to describe someone who cares about others.

He is very friendly. → use this to say someone is easy to talk to and warm.

Let's try together. → use this when you want to practice with someone else.

Take your time. → use this to tell someone not to hurry, it's okay to go slowly.

It's a gentle word. → use this to say a word feels soft and nice.

You are doing well. → use this to encourage someone who is learning.
